



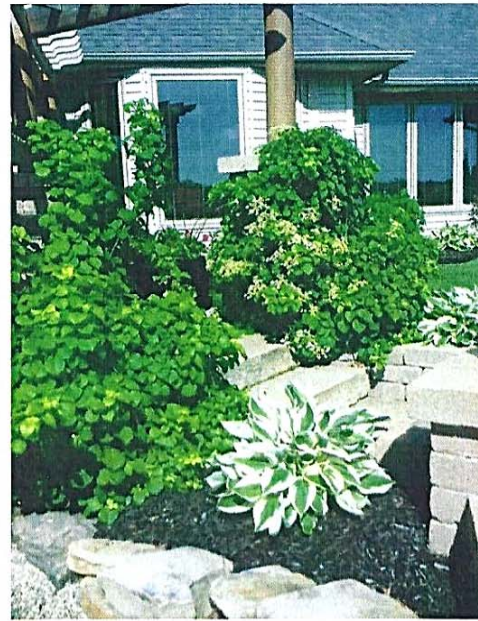
Marsh Foundation

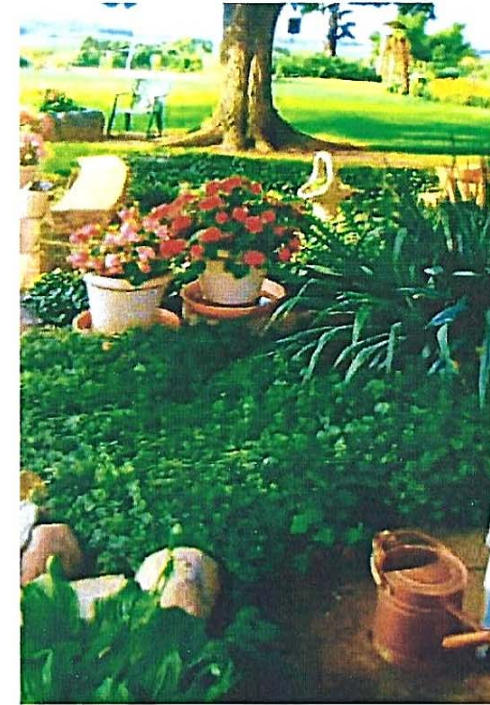


1034 Shawnee Dr
